WELLINGTON TO WATERLOO (W2W) 24-27th September 2013

There is less than two weeks until the start of the Colonel's Fund Bicycle Ride. Some 200 riders have signed up to go and the final recce is taking place as we write. Subject to final tweaks, everything appears to be in place for a challenging and hopefully rewarding event.

The aim is to raise a substantial sum of money for the Colonel's Fund. Each rider has been asked to raise a target of £1,700 to cover the associated costs of the ride (food, accommodation, channel crossings etc.) whilst leaving a margin for the fund.

Whilst some riders have already raised many times the target amount, others have found it more of a struggle. In particular, some of the riders in the 1st Battalion are currently well short of the required sum. Clearly, every pound under the target is a pound that will not go to the fund. Hence the reason for this letter.
